Here are a few details for our upcoming API 510 class.

Class Date: **December 16-21, 2019** (All day Saturday!) Class exam begins Saturday at 8:00 am. Exam takes about 4-6 hrs. Don't rush, act like it's the real API exam. Very important for 1st time API'ers!

API Exam Dates: **January 3rd-17th, 2019** You must schedule the exact date with Prometrics. It's best to have **at least 2 weeks** between the Class & the Exam!

Class Location: **Conference Center at the Hotel Francis** in St. Francisville, La.

API Application: Your API application must be completed at API's website by **November 1, 2019**. It is now an online application found on API's web-site. Once API accepts your application, they will provide an ID number. This will be used to schedule your test at the Prometrics test site of your choice.

Code Books: Even though the test is on-line, we will be using paper Codes in the class. Be sure to check the API website to determine the exact codes that you need for this exam. These codes can be purchased through **IHS or Techstreet**. You can find their website via Links on the MSTS website.

Pre-Study: **You really need to STUDY before the class.** A very intense week! Pre-class study is a must! Info on our website to download includes:
API 510 Study Guide: What to study prior to the class
API 572 Study Questions: About 200 questions to help you "stay awake" as you study API 572. We will **not** cover API 572 in class.
The Inspector's Calcs: Self study guide & quiz on Corrosion Rate, Remaining Life, and Inspection Interval calculations.

Bring to Class: **Calculator** - Suggest a basic calculator with square root function.
Red Pen & Pencils - Mechanical pencils preferred
Highlighters (yellow, pink, orange)
Printed Code Books - (Make sure you have the Correct editions for the testing period you choose)
