Here are a few details for our upcoming API 510 class.

Class Date: **August 22-27** All day Saturday! Class exam begins Saturday at 7:30 am. Exam takes 4-6 hours. Don't rush, act like it's the real API exam.

API Exam Date: **Sept 9-30** You must schedule the exact date with Prometrics.

API Application: Your API Application must be completed online at API's website by **July 8, 2022**. Once accepted, API provides an ID # that is used to schedule your exam at the Prometrics test site of your choice. See MSTs website's Links page for API's and Prometric's website.

API Info: The API web-site (www.api.org/icp) offers useful information. (i.e. Application, Body of Knowledge, List of Required Codes)

Code Books: Even though the test is on-line, we will be using paper Codes in the class. Be sure to check the API website to determine the exact codes that you need for this exam. These codes can be purchased through **IHS or Techstreet**. See MSTs website's Links Page.

Pre-Study: **You really need to STUDY before the class.** This is an intense week! Pre-class study will make your class easier! You will also score higher on the API exam. Info on our website to download includes:
API 510 Study Guide: What to study prior to the class
API 572 Study Questions: About 200 questions to help you "stay awake" as you study API 572. We will **not** cover API 572 in class.

The Inspector's Calcs: Self study guide & quiz on Corrosion Rate, Remaining Life, and Inspection Interval calculations.

Bring to Class: **Calculator** - Suggest a simple calculator with square root
Red Pen & Pencils - Mechanical pencils preferred
Straight edge - About 6-8" long

Directions to Class (from Houston Intercontinental Airport using Hardy Toll Rd):

- 1) For 1 mile keep left onto **Will Clayton Pkwy** toward **Hardy Toll Road**
- 2) Go 2.3 miles and keep right to merge onto **Hardy Toll Road W**
- 3) Go 3 miles and keep right on **Hardy Toll Rd N** towards **Woodlands, I-45N**
- 4) Go 28 miles and take exit 89 toward **Teas Nursery Rd, FM-3083**
- 5) Go 1 mile and turn right onto **Teas Nursery Road**
- 6) Turn left at 250 ft and arrive at **3000 IH-45 N, Conroe, Texas 77303**
